The Santa Cruz Chorale concludes its 2016–2017 season with the June concert, “Fauré Requiem and Mendelssohn Motets.” Our June concert highlights works by two composers of the Romantic Period: Gabriel Fauré and Felix Mendelssohn. The centerpiece of the program is one of Fauré’s most famous works, the *Requiem* for soprano and baritone soloists, choir, orchestra and organ. The *Requiem* will be preceded by Fauré’s *Cantique de Jean Racine*, showing the influence of Mendelssohn on the young Fauré. As an homage to Mendelssohn, the concert will include two of his lesser known cantatas for choir and orchestra. Pieces by romantics Charles Villier Stanford and Edward Elgar round out the program.
